※ Applicant and parents must be in the status of not having Korean nationalities before the application
 - 2) Applicant including overseas Korean who completed the entire education outside Korea
 - 3) North Korean Refugees

❷ Application documents should be submitted online.

- Application documents should be submitted online, and only accepted students will be required to submit the original documents via postal or in person by the notified due.
- Applicant should submit an online application with all the required documents scanned and uploaded in PDF form. (refer to the p.5-6)
- Applicant may be requested to submit additional documents via postal by the department office for evaluation.

❸ This is the 1st round for the Spring 2026 intake.

- The 2nd and 3rd rounds will be held if necessary, but the number of available departments may be limited.
